In general, participating employees and their beneficiaries have the power and authority to direct the voting of shares of Common Stock allocated to their individual accounts through the Plan Trustees (who have shared voting and dispositive power over the allocated shares), subject to the fiduciary duties of the Plan Trustees and applicable law. Any unallocated shares of Common Stock are generally voted by the Plan Trustees in their discretion, subject to the fiduciary duties of the Plan Trustees and applicable law.
