Amended and Restated 2000 Employee Stock Purchase Plan (the ESPP), and together with the 2009 Plan, the Plans as a result of one or more adjustments under the Plans to prevent dilution resulting from one or more stock splits, stock dividends or similar transactions.
- (2) Pursuant to Securities Act Rule 457(h), the maximum offering price, per share and in the aggregate, and the registration fee were calculated based upon the average of the high and low prices of the Common Stock on July 26, 2013, as quoted on the Nasdaq Global Select Market.

As of July 31, 2013, Mr. Ko owns 12,427 shares of Common Stock, 44,028 restricted stock units that are payable in an equivalent number of shares of Common Stock, and Company stock options to acquire up to an additional 15,000 shares of Common Stock. Mr. Ko is eligible to receive stock awards by the Company under the Plan.
