- (1) Received in exchange for 3,000,000 DAP Units over shares of Discovery Holding Company ("DHC") Series A common stock at an original beginning unit value of \$17.70, in connection with the merger of DHC with a wholly-owned subsidiary of the company (the "Merger"). Under the terms of the DAP Plan, the conversion of outstanding DAP units could not be calculated until 10 trading days of the company's Series A common stock had passed.
 - (2) DAP Units vest in three equal annual installments beginning January 2, 2008. On each vesting date, the vested DAP Units are automatically cashed out.
 - (3) Received in exchange for 1,000,000 DAP Units over shares of DHC Series A common stock at an original beginning unit value of \$27.38, in connection with the Merger. Under the terms of the DAP Plan, the conversion of outstanding DAP units could not be calculated until 10 trading days of the company's Series A common stock had passed.
 - (4) DAP Units vest in four equal annual installments beginning January 2, 2009. On each vesting date, the vested DAP Units are automatically cashed out.
