The article, entitled “Proliferation resistant plutonium: An updated analysis,” explores the proliferation resistance of Lightbridge’s fuel. The authors performed an independent evaluation via computer simulation of Lightbridge’s fuel design for a pressurized water reactor and came to the conclusion that the resultant plutonium would be useless in current nuclear weapon designs.
