- (1) The sale reported in this Form 4 was effected pursuant to a Rule 10b5-1 trading plan adopted by the reporting person.  
 The common stock is subject to certain restrictions. Restrictions on 5,000 shares lapse on each of the next 4 anniversary dates of the grant date, however the restrictions may lapse sooner if certain acceleration criteria are met. The acceleration criteria are as follows: If the Company is profitable for the fiscal year ended December 31, 2006 the restrictions will lapse at the rate of 6,666 shares per year over the first 3 years on the date of the anniversary of the grant; if the Company is profitable for the fiscal years ended December 31, 2006 and 2007 the restrictions will lapse at the rate of 10,000 shares per year over the first 2 years on the date of the anniversary of the grant. If the Company is not profitable for the fiscal year ended December 31, 2006 but is profitable for the fiscal year ended December 31, 2007 the restrictions will lapse at the rate of 6,666 shares per year over the first 3 years on the date of the anniversary of the grant.
