Performance Shares awarded pursuant to the Exelon Long Term Incentive Plan. 1/3 of the shares awarded vest immediately upon receipt.
  - (1) The remaining shares vest in 1/3 increments on each of the first and second anniversaries of the grant date. Under certain circumstances some or all of the vested shares may be settled in cash on a 1 for 1 basis based on the cash value of the underlying stock on the date of vesting.
  - (2) Vested amount includes 1/3 of the current grant, the second 1/3 of the grant made in January 2008 and the third and final 1/3 of the grant made in January 2007.
  - (3) Shares withheld by the Issuer for reporting person's tax obligation.
  - (4) Shares settled in cash on a 1 for 1 basis.  
Shares held as of 12/31/2008 in a multi-fund 401(k) Plan to be settled in cash upon the reporting person's termination of employment for any reason on a 1:1 basis. Shares are acquired through regular periodic contributions, company matching contributions, and the automatic reinvestment of dividends.
  - (6) Non qualified employee stock options, awarded pursuant to the Exelon Long Term Incentive Plan. Options vest in 1/4 increments on each of the first four anniversaries of the grant date, referenced in column one, and expire on the tenth anniversary of the grant date.
