## Explanation of Responses:

- (1) Based on Company performance during the 2014-2016 period, approximately 106.7% of the performance units vested (as previously disclosed, the reporting person had the opportunity to earn up to 200% of the number originally reported, subject to plan limits).
- (2) Shares were withheld to cover tax withholding upon the vesting of performance units.
- (3) 1 for 1.  
 Based on Company performance during fiscal 2016, approximately 116.2% of the restricted stock units originally granted were earned (as previously disclosed, the reporting person had the opportunity to earn up to 200% of the number of units originally reported, subject to plan limits). Assuming continued employment through the end of fiscal 2018, the units will then vest in one installment and the shares will be issued shortly thereafter.
- (4) Original option grant vests in three annual installments beginning on the date listed in the "Date Exercisable" column.
- (5) The transaction was an option grant. Accordingly, the reporting person did not pay a price to obtain the option.

Assuming continued employment through the end of fiscal 2019, any units earned will then vest in one installment and the shares will be issued shortly thereafter. The target number of units that may be earned is reported above; the maximum number is 200% of the number reported, subject to plan limits.
- (7) The restricted stock units were earned based on Company performance during fiscal 2015. Assuming continued employment through the end of fiscal 2017, the units will then vest in one installment and the shares will be issued shortly thereafter.
- (8) If the Company achieves certain goals over the 2015-2017 period, the performance units will vest and stock will be awarded. The target number of units that may be earned is reported above; the maximum amount is 200% of the number reported, subject to plan limits.
- (9) If the Company achieves certain goals over the 2016-2018 period, the performance units will vest and stock will be awarded. The target number of units that may be earned is reported above; the maximum amount is 200% of the number reported, subject to plan limits.
