**Evaluation of Disclosure Controls and Procedures**

TransAlta has designed disclosure controls and procedures to ensure that material information relating to the Company, including its consolidated subsidiaries, is made known to the Chief Executive Officer and Chief Financial Officer by others within the Company, including its consolidated subsidiaries, on a regular basis, in particular during the period in which its Current Reports on Form 6-K relating to quarterly financial results are being prepared. 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**TransAlta closes sale of US\$300 million of senior notes**

CALGARY, Alberta (Nov. 25, 2003) - TransAlta Corporation (TSX: TA; NYSE: TAC) announced today the closing of its previously announced public offering in the United States of 10-year senior notes due 2013. The notes bear interest at a rate of 5.750 per cent and mature on Dec. 15, 2013.

TransAlta raised gross proceeds of US\$300 million from this offering through a syndicate of underwriters lead-managed by Citigroup and Merrill Lynch & Co. The notes were sold only through a prospectus supplement to TransAlta's previously filed US\$1.0 billion shelf registration statement dated May 14, 2002 with the U.S. Securities and Exchange Commission.

*TransAlta is among Canada's largest non-regulated power generation and wholesale marketing companies. We have close to \$9 billion in coal-fired, gas-fired, hydro and renewable generation assets in Canada, the U.S., Mexico and Australia. With approximately 10,000 megawatts of capacity either in operation, under construction or in development, our focus is to efficiently operate our assets in order to provide our wholesale customers with a reliable, low-cost source of power.*
