- (1) Vesting of 61,440 restricted stock units exempt pursuant to Rule 16b-3. The payout was based on the level of achievement of financial targets for the performance period ended September 30, 2010. The restricted stock units were subject to a one-year vesting period. The payout of the other 60% was previously reported.
