- (1) Cashless stock option exercise of 30,000 share options granted on 02/17/03 at the option price of \$49.60 per share with tax withholding rights. Immediate sale through broker of 29,000 shares. 1,000 shares were retained from the exercise.
  - (2) 4,688 shares are held in name of the undersigned's broker.
  - (3) Award of 3,733 phantom stock shares (Strategic Excellence Program) awarded on 02/14/05 under the 2002 Whirlpool Corporation Omnibus Stock and Incentive Plan in transactions exempt under Rule 16(b)-3(c). Time restrictions will lapse and shares will become vested as follows: 50% on 02/14/06; and 50% on 02/14/07.
  - (4) 724.50 phantom stock deferred under the Executive Deferred Savings Plan in transactions exempt under Rule 16b-3. As of 02/14/05, 724.50 total phantom shares deferred.

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- (5) Deferral of payout of 12,266.37 phantom restricted shares (Special Retention Program) awarded under the 1998 Whirlpool Corporation Omnibus Stock and Incentive Plan in transactions exempt under Rule 16(b)-3(c). As of 12/15/04, the latest date for which information is reasonably available, 12,343.19 total phantom shares deferred, which includes dividend equivalents earned in phantom restricted stock.
- (6) 12,500 phantom stock shares (Special Retention Program) awarded under the Whirlpool Corporation 1998 Omnibus Stock and Incentive Plan in transactions exempt under Rule 16(b)-3(c). Shares will vest on 11/26/08. Participants may elect to defer receipt of vested shares. Dividend equivalents on deferred stock will be invested in additional stock.
- (7) 30,000 phantom stock shares (Special Retention Program) awarded on 06/14/2004 with the effective date of the award to be 07/01/2004 under the Whirlpool Corporation 2002 Omnibus Stock and Incentive Plan in transactions exempt under Rule 16(b)-3(c). Shares will become vested as follows: 50% on 07/01/2007 and 50% on 07/01/2011. Participants may elect to defer receipt of vested shares. Dividend equivalents on deferred stock will be invested in additional stock.
- (8) 25,000 option shares with cashless exercise and tax withholding rights awarded on 11/26/01 at the option price of \$66.62 per share. All shares are currently exercisable, and will expire 10 years from date of grant.
- (9) Original grant of 25,000 phantom stock shares (Career Stock Award) awarded under the 1996 Omnibus Stock and Incentive Plan in transactions exempt under Rule 16(b)-3(c). Phantom shares will become vested as follows: 10,000 shares on 11/26/06; 10,000 shares on 11/26/10; and 5,000 shares on retirement after age 60. As of 12/15/2004, the latest date for which information is reasonably available, 26,955.01 total phantom shares deferred, which includes dividend equivalents earned in phantom restricted stock.
- (10) 27,000 option shares with cashless exercise and tax withholding rights awarded on 2/18/02 at the option price of \$67.29 per share. All shares are currently exercisable, and will expire 10 years from date of grant.
- (11) 10,772 option shares with cashless exercise and tax withholding rights awarded on 02/16/04 at the option price of \$72.94 per share. 3,591 shares are currently exercisable, with the remaining shares to become exercisable as follows: one-third on 02/16/06; and one-third on 02/16/07. The options will expire 10 years from date of grant.
