Novo Nordisk A/S - Share repurchase programme

Bagsværd, Denmark, 13 March 2017 – On 2 February 2017, Novo Nordisk initiated a share repurchase programme in accordance with Article 5 of Regulation No. 596/2014 of the European Parliament and Council of 16 April 2014 (MAR), also referred to as the Safe Harbour rules. This programme is part of the overall share repurchase programme of up to DKK 16 billion to be executed during a 12-month period beginning 2 February 2017.

Under the programme initiated 2 February 2017, Novo Nordisk will repurchase B shares for an amount up to DKK 4.0 billion in the period from 2 February 2017 to 1 May 2017.

Since the announcement as of 6 March 2017, the following transactions have been made under the programme:

The details for each transaction made under the share repurchase programme are published on novonordisk.com.

Transactions related to Novo Nordisk's incentive programmes have resulted in a net sale by Novo Nordisk of 38,143 B shares in the period from 6 March 2017 to 10 March 2017. The shares in these transactions were not part of the Safe Harbour repurchase programme.

With the transactions stated above, Novo Nordisk owns a total of 58,744,130 B shares of DKK 0.20, corresponding to 2.3% of the share capital, as treasury shares. The total amount of A and B shares in the company is 2,550,000,000 including treasury shares.

Novo Nordisk expects to repurchase B shares for an amount up to DKK 16 billion during a 12-month period beginning 2 February 2017. As of 10 March 2017, Novo Nordisk has repurchased a total of 7,663,075 B shares equal to a transaction value of DKK 1,846,933,085.

Novo Nordisk is a global healthcare company with more than 90 years of innovation and leadership in diabetes care. This heritage has given us experience and capabilities that also enable us to help people defeat other serious chronic conditions: haemophilia, growth disorders and obesity. Headquartered in Denmark, Novo Nordisk employs approximately 42,000 people in 77 countries and markets its products in more than 165 countries. Novo Nordisk's B shares are listed on Nasdaq Copenhagen (Novo-B). Its ADRs are listed on the New York Stock Exchange (NVO).
