This Report of Foreign Private Issuer on Form 6-K is deemed filed for all purposes under the Securities Act of 1933, as amended, and the Securities Exchange Act of 1934, as amended, including by reference in the Registration Statement on Form F-3 (Registration No. 33-99550) and the Registration Statement on Form F-3 (Registration No. 333-9180).

On December 3, 2008, Saudi Electricity Company (SEC) announced that the consortium (Consortium) consisting of Korea Electric Power Corporation (KEPCO) and Arabian Company for Water and Power Projects Limited (ACWA), a Saudi Arabian company, has submitted the lowest bid for the construction of a heavy oil power plant at Rabigh in Saudi Arabia (the Project). The power generation capacity of the Project is approximately 1,200MW and the Project will be pursued on a Build, Own, and Operate basis. SEC will formally evaluate the commercial, legal and technical aspects of all of the submitted bids following which a First Ranked Bidder will be announced.
