(1) Disposed of pursuant to the merger agreement between issuer and Plains Exploration & Production Company in exchange for aggregate consideration of \$58,4833/share (which may consist of cash, Plains stock, or a combination thereof) as provided for in the merger agreement.

(2) This option which provided for vesting in three equal annual installments beginning August 1, 2001 was converted in the merger into a cash payment of \$76,341.60 representing the product of the number of shares subject to the option and the difference between the exercise price of the option and the aggregate consideration per share provided for in the merger agreement.
