Shares acquired pursuant to conversion of Restricted Stock Units (RSUs) on a one-for-one basis. RSUs issued pursuant to Management Stock Purchase Plan under which executive may make an advance election to receive RSUs in lieu of specified percentage or dollar amount of annual incentive cash bonus under bonus plan applicable to executive. RSUs are issued in whole units on the basis of a 33% discount from the fair market value of the issuer's common stock on the date the underlying bonus is determined (\$9.45 in this case) and generally vest 3 years from the date of the grant, at which time they convert into shares of common stock unless the executive has previously selected a longer deferral period. Transactions reported reflect conversion of RSUs into shares and withholding of sufficient shares to pay taxes.

(1) discount from the fair market value of the issuer's common stock on the date the underlying bonus is determined (\$9.45 in this case) and generally vest 3 years from the date of the grant, at which time they convert into shares of common stock unless the executive has previously selected a longer deferral period.
