ITEM 2.02 RESULTS OF OPERATIONS AND FINANCIAL CONDITION.

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On March 11, 2005, Alfacell Corporation issued a press release to report its results of operations and financial condition for the quarter ended January 31, 2005. A copy of the press release is attached hereto as Exhibit 99.1, which is incorporated into this Item 2.02 by reference.

ITEM 8.01 OTHER EVENTS.

On March 11, 2005, Alfacell Corporation reported an extension in the expected time frame for the completion of patient accrual in its malignant mesothelioma Phase IIIb trial. Recent regulatory changes in several large, non-EU countries which have contracted to participate in the trial have occurred. Specifically, local government approvals must now be obtained prior to the initiation of trials in those countries. As a result, patient accrual has been delayed.

The Company continues to enroll patients in those countries for which it has government approvals to conduct trials, including the United States, Canada, Poland, Italy, Germany and most recently Australia and New Zealand. The Company has been successful in accelerating patient accrual in these countries and will continue to use its best efforts to accelerate accruals at all sites. The Company expects to achieve projected patient accruals once the local government approvals are granted. The Company continues to focus on rapid patient enrollment in order to accelerate the completion of the Phase IIIb trial in parallel with the completion of all the required sections of the NDA.
