- (1) Each performance-based restricted stock unit represented a contingent right to receive a share of issuer's common stock upon satisfaction of financial performance criteria for the three-year performance period ended January 31, 2009 and publication of issuer's financial statements for the fiscal year-ended on that date. 79,000 units were granted pursuant to the Tiffany & Co. 2005 Employee Incentive Plan, which complies with Rule 16(b)-3. 50,244 units not eligible for conversion at the end of the performance period were canceled.
- (2) Shares were sold to cover taxes on vested restricted stock units.

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- (3) These shares were previously reported as directly beneficially owned but were contributed to a grantor retained annuity trust dated May 22, 2008.

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
