(1) The shares were sold pursuant to a sales plan adopted by the reporting person and intended to comply with Rule 10b5-1 under the Securities Exchange Act of 1934.

(4) The stock option vests upon achievement of certain performance metrics in any four consecutive fiscal quarters completed during the term of the stock option.
