(1) This transaction was executed in multiple trades at prices ranging from \$31.53 to \$32.35. The price reported in Column 4 is a weighted average price. The reporting person hereby undertakes to provide upon request to the SEC staff, the issuer or a security holder of the issuer full information regarding the number of shares and prices at which the transactions were effected.

(2) On February 29, 2012, the Compensation Committee determined that these performance-based restricted stock rights vested based on the company achieving financial performance goals for the period ending December 31, 2011.

(3) Represents shares forfeited to the company in connection with the satisfaction of tax liabilities incurred upon the vesting of the performance-based restricted stock rights.
