(a) Termination of Previous Independent Accountants.

As previously reported in current reports on Form 8-K and Form 8-K/A filed with the Securities and Exchange Commission on May 29, 2002 and June 4, 2002, respectively, the Registrant, on May 20, 2002, dismissed its independent public accountants, Arthur Andersen LLP.

(b) Engagement of New Independent Accountants

Following approval by the Audit Committee of the Board of Directors, the Registrant on August 6, 2002 engaged Rotenberg & Company, LLP to serve as the Registrant's independent auditors for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2002.
